IS YOUR WATER RIGHT ON THE LIST?

WHAT IS IT?

Abandonment is the termination of a water right by the State of Colorado due to failure to use and/or document use. View the 2020 Abandonment List at dwr.colorado.gov/services/water-administration/water-rights#abandonment

WHAT CAN YOU DO IF YOU ARE ON THE LIST?

1. Call the Division of Water Resources [DWR], Division Six at 970.879.0272
2. File an objection by July 31, 2021 with DWR
dwr.colorado.gov/services/water-administration/water-rights#abandonment
3. Verify you have been removed from the list by December 31, 2021

WHAT NOW?

If you are still on the list, you may file a written protest with the Colorado Water Court by June 30, 2022

STAY OFF THE LIST BY:

Keeping records of use [written or photo] and submitting to DWR
